Or perhaps you like a picturesque village with a unique character. Then Kanne certainly may not be omitted from your list of things to see. The white marl village with its mysterious marl caves give Riemst its well-earned nickname: 'The marl region of Flanders'.

But Riemst also has other assets! You can enjoy cycling and hiking and be amazed by the many panoramic views. Relax at the Waterburcht (moated castle) in Millen or allow yourself to be shown the sights during a covered wagon or boat trip. Do you prefer cities but still want to stay where it is restful? In that case we are the ideal starting point for visits to the cities of Hasselt, Liège, Maastricht and Tongeren that are surprisingly close by.

Experience Centre at "De Brug" (The bridge)

The view alone is breath taking at De Brug in Vroenhoven. From the terrace of Brasserie "Onder De Brug" you have a magnificent panorama of the Albert Canal and the Haspengouw hills. But "under the bridge" there is also a unique experience centre that leaves few visitors unmoved.

The interactive experience centre builds a bridge between the two topics that come together at this particular location. The destruction of the Second World War on the one hand, and the innovative power of the Albert Canal and inland shipping on the other.

The battle at and around Vroenhoven bridge was the beginning of World War II for Belgium. You experience the invasion from hour to hour as seen through the eyes of soldiers and citizens.

At the same time, the Inland Shipping Experience helps you understand the importance of this location. This is not simply the place where the war began in our country. It is also on a transportation network that has great value for our economy and the climate.

First Belgian World Peace Flame

Did you know that on the 29th of April 2012 the first World Peace Flame of Belgium was ignited at the Vroenhoven Bridge? The everlasting flame shines in a 2 metre high glass monument. It is a unique symbol of peace at this historic place. World Peace Flame Riemst is part of the international World Peace Flame network.



Fort Eben-Emael

The "unconquerable" Fort of Eben-Emael became famous at the outbreak of World War II on May 10, 1940. A small team of German paratroopers was able to gain control of the artillery of the fort in less than 15 minutes. Visit Fort Eben-Emael and discover the incredible adventure of World War II's first moments, as well as learning about daily life in this giant fortress.

Former NATO Headquarters



The marl caves of Kanne

In Riemst, the white and soft limestone walls reveal an underground pearl. Centuries ago, when South Limburg was still under the sea, the lime in the seashells was mixed with clay. The result? Marl! Years of marl mining resulted in a special underground maze: the marl caves!

In Kanne, marl mining began before the 15th century. Villagers used the stones to build local churches and castles. During the tour you will discover how this was done, see beautiful wall paintings of prehistoric animals and discover our new Flemish regional product: cave champagne!

In the marl caves of Zichen-Bolder you will find wall paintings in charcoal, sculptures in marl sandstone, fossils from the Krijtzee, drawings and inscriptions. Pssst ... you also pass a real bat reservation and a little farther you can see how Cave Cheese is ripened. You will also learn all the details of the artisan mining technique of the marl block breakers.



With its 22 ha of vineyards, this is the oldest, largest and most versatile vineyard in Belgium.

During your visit you will take a walk through the park, around the castle with its beautiful arboretum of ancient rare trees, and you have a view of Belgium's most extensive vineyards and of a rose garden with almost 1000 rose bushes in 24 different types and colours.

The guides will show you the old carriage house with an ultra modern grape press, the distillery of Limburgs Levenswater, and the heart of the Wine Castle: the ancient and new wine cellars.

In a fascinating, humorous and interactive way, you will be informed about the past, the present and the future of the domain, the work in the vineyards and the complete vinification process from grape to wine.

Hidden attractions in Millen

Traditional brickworks



More than 50 years ago, grandfather Parthoens began constructing the ring oven furnace. Bricks are still being baked in this oven, but now by the third generation. According to a strict press procedure a unique facade brick is made using a traditional production process for which time has stood still.

Riemst is Purveyor to the Court for mushrooms. In the past they were grown in the marl caves because they have a perfect climate for growing mushrooms throughout the year. But there was a change in the early 1950s. The modernization of cultivation technology moved mushroom cultivation above ground.

Visit the Kazematten of Maastricht with a bomb shelter exposition.

Between 1575 and 1825, on the western side of Maastricht there was a network of corridors and mine galleries: the Kazematten. Like moles underground, people in the 18th century, dug a 14 kilometre long defence system. These corridors were used to approach the enemy underground and render them harmless during a siege of the city.

During World War II, the people of Maastricht spent fearful hours here as they took cover during bombing raids. OR

Visit the Zonneberg Caves.

A spacious and structured system with about 80 km of cathedral-like corridors. An experienced guide takes you underground where many names and drawings of people are seen. After all, a large portion of the Maastricht population found shelter here during WWII. You discover an evacuation space with electric lights, a public-address installation, a bakery, toilettes, a chapel, a hospital, water pumping stations and much more.

16.00 hrs | End.

Your visit starts with an introduction in the castle. Then you get in the covered wagon and the Belgian work horses take you through the vineyards. You enjoy a special wine degustation during your trip because the wine domain has various types of grapes that you will become familiar with in the vineyard. In conclusion you visit the wine cellars and you can relax for a while on the terrace of the castle.

DURATION:

± 3 hours (start between 9 and 15 hrs)

PERIOD

The tour can be reserved the whole year (except Sundays and holidays) but can only go ahead if weather conditions allow it. For the degustation, various formulas are possible.





Survive-All

Survive-All is an organisation of survival specialists in extremes, management training courses, and outdoor-activities. Most of the survival exercises take place south of St. Peter's mountain in the town of Eben-Emael.

A sample of the activities:

• Compass short-cut:

By using nothing but a compass and an assigned compass route, you make your way through terrain that is difficult to cross.

• Climbing:

Completely safe and after instruction, by using arm, leg and brain power, you try to conquer a natural wall. At the top you have a beautiful view.

• Rope course:

A challenging rope course at a height of \pm 6 meter that you can conquer on your own after receiving safety instructions.

• Running-down:

running down a 12, 25, 40 and 60 metre wall, including map exercise, equipment and supervision.





The Flemish Centre for Agricultural and Fishery Marketing has recognised Riemst cave mushrooms as a Flemish regional product! In our community, the mushroom nursery of Jos Coenegrachts is the only active professional underground mushroom nursery where Purple Knight, Chestnut and Anise mushrooms are grown. You can buy them in a few neighbourhood shops or taste them in our eating establishments!



Cave Cheese

The natural conditions in the marl caves facilitate the production of Cave Cheese. An ideal pure atmosphere and a very constant temperature give the cheese a perfect, mild aroma and it gains its typical taste thanks to a bath in Cave Beer.

Honey and quinoa

Taste delicious honey from Riemst from the bees of our beekeepers, Luc Loyens and Kristof Odeur. Or try something new: quinoa. It is a nutritious alternative for rice, couscous, pasta and potatoes. It is healthful and gluten free and recently has begun to be grown in Riemst!

Riemster Dröpke is a light sweet jenever flavoured with elder flowers with or without quince. Or may it be liqueur? Caester Likeur is a liqueur flavoured with rose bud or hawthorn. Hesbania is a blond regional beer refermented in the bottle, characterful and with a refined aroma. Do you have trouble making a choice between blond and brown?
